*Rain or Shine*

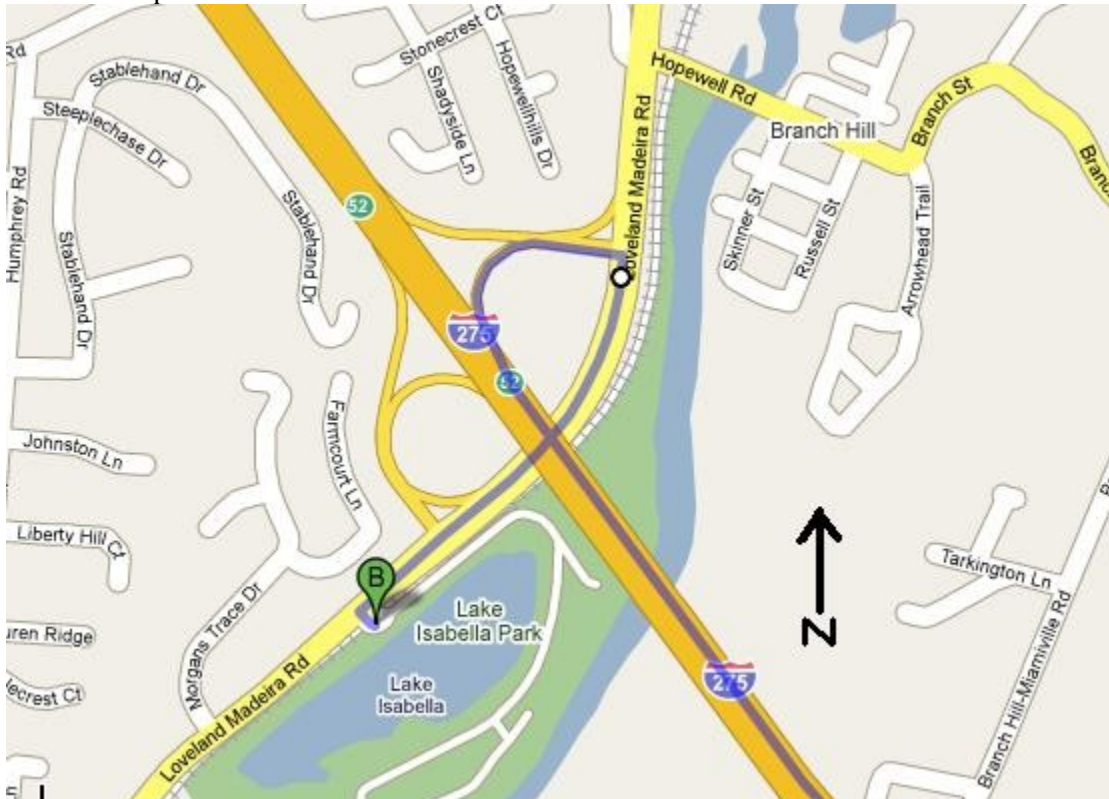


### DERBY DRIVING DIRECTIONS & INSTRUCTIONS:

Lake Isabella is a Hamilton County Park, located just off Exit 53 off I-275. Directions:

1. Take I-275 North towards Milford.
2. Take exit 52 Indian Hill/Loveland and turn RIGHT off the exit.
3. Turn LEFT at the sign for Lake Isabella (~.5 mi)
4. Follow park road to lake – signs will be posted. Registration will be on the main patio, or if raining, inside the bait shop.

**Final registration will be open from 8AM – 8:45AM on the day of the event.** Pre-registration is encouraged – it helps us to plan, and reduces your price. At 8:45AM, we will gather to review the schedule for the day, distribute bait, and give final instructions for the derby. Fishing will end promptly at 1:00 pm. The lake has a well stocked bait & equipment shop. Feel free to patronize this shop -you are not required to use provided bait. KOC will provide lunch consisting of hot dogs, burgers, chips, pop for all present. Please feel free to bring a favorite dish to share with your fellow derby'ers. Judges will review derby results during lunch to determine prize winners. Prizes will consist of fishing and sports equipment (no cash prizes).

General “derby” rules will be followed – we expect all participating to exhibit good sportsmanship. A family prize will be awarded for most fish caught. Individual prizes will be awarded based on number of fish caught, and largest fish by weight. This is a “catch and release” contest. Once you have caught a fish, **please get the attention of a judge immediately** so that it can be properly recorded. Once recorded, the fish will be released back into the lake. One hook/lure per person, no stringers please.

**Important Additional Information:**

Lake Isabella is a Hamilton County park. The park has graciously waived all fishing fees for kids 15 and under for this event. There is a general entrance fee of \$2 per car per day, or you can purchase a season pass for \$5, which covers all Hamilton County parks. This nominal fee helps to maintain the great parks we all have the opportunity to enjoy in the Greater Cincinnati area.

This is a family event, no alcohol please.

This event is open to the public without discrimination. You do **not** need to be affiliated with the Knights of Columbus or any other organization to participate. We encourage those with special needs to participate. If you or your child has a special need, please let us know so that we can enable your full participation!

This event will be held regardless of weather. In case of rain, please dress accordingly. **There are no refunds.**
